Aubrey's Commitment

_____ I agree to do my best to teach musical concepts until the student fully understands them.

_____ I will listen to the student's musical aspirations and needs and plan lessons accordingly.

_____ I will set short and long term goals with the student so that we are on the same page.

_____ I understand that life can sometimes get in the way of things, and will be flexible and kind if weekly practice goals aren't always met and progress isn't made that week.

_____ I will be as flexible as possible in scheduling and understanding of individual needs. **I will give at least 4 hours advance notice** if cancellation is necessary on my end. Any lesson cancelled and not rescheduled on my end will be a *qualifying absence.

_____ 's Commitment

_____ Because of the non-traditional nature of Aubrey's teaching style, it often takes a few weeks to notice visible progress. I agree to attend at least 4 consecutive weeks of lessons before quitting.

_____ I understand that consistent lessons and consistent practicing will produce the best results. I agree to review lesson notes and practice each week.

_____ I understand that Aubrey does not believe in traditional method books but may utilize their lesson and theory resources according to student learning styles and needs.

_____ I will do my best to communicate my musical needs and aspirations to Aubrey so that she can help me. If I don't understand what she is teaching me I will tell her.

_____ Monthly payments are due at the first lesson of each month. Payment for individual lessons is due at time of lesson. I will to pay the agreed upon amount of \$_____ at its due date.

_____ I will be punctual to each lesson, and if I'm running late I will let Aubrey know before the lesson's start time

_____ I understand that **notice of absence is required at least 1 hour in advance**. Lesson rescheduling is preferred. *4 absences with adequate notice will result in a free calendar month of lessons. Aubrey will keep note of qualifying absences.

_____ I will forgive Aubrey if she accidentally goes on a tangent about a musical concept she is passionate about :)
